The school continues to work closely with the Careers and Enterprise company and as a result receive support and guidance from a dedicated SEN Carers and Enterprise Co-ordinator, Claire Donnelly and a Careers Enterprise Advisor, Julie Venn-Morton. As part of this support the school are required to meet government deadlines where the Compass Tracker is completed. This is completed throughout the year and feeds into an action plan that is regularly updated.
